What is AYSO Challenge?

- Club-level soccer WITHIN the AYSO program
- Another rung on the "player development ladder"
- Shared Philosophies



How the Program Works

- Players are dual-registered with AYSO and Cal-South
- Coaches are certified by both AYSO and USSF
- Annual Player Tryouts
- Compete in the Coast Soccer League and CalSouth affiliated tournaments
- Calendar Year Age Cutoffs



Program Facts

- Estimated Registration fee of only \$350
 - Player must also be registered with a "Home" AYSO Region of their choice
- Rosters capped at 15 players *(U10 capped at 11 players)*
- Guaranteed minimum of 50% playtime
- Includes Coast Soccer League, League Cup and State Cup
- Referee Fees Additional, Shared by team players



AYSO Leadership

- Area-wide program (Quartz Hill, Lancaster, Palmdale, Victorville, Hesperia, Tri-Com Regions)
- Area Oversight (Area Challenge Director, Treasurer, Registrar, and Director of Coaching
- Board Member and Commissioner Oversight
- Coach Interview and Selection Panel
- Ensuring AYSO Philosophies are Maintained



Program Timetable

- Currently Accepting Coach Applications
- Coach Selection in February
- Player Tryouts in March & April
- Roster/Player Selection by May Ist
- Deposit due by May 8th, Roster Freeze on May 15th
- Practices May begin June Ist
- Pre-Season tournaments July and August
- Coast Soccer League Begins September 10th
